WORK UNDERWAY ON WOODBINE STREESCAPE PHASE 3

Woodbine—Mayor William Pikolycky announces that work is underway for the long-awaited third phase of the Washington Avenue Streetscapes Improvements is finally underway. This phase of the overall Streetscape Improvements will include construction of brick paver crosswalks and intersection paving on Washington Avenue at the intersections of Webster Street, Clay Street, Franklin Street, DeHirsch Avenue, and Route 550.

During the course of construction, various street closings will be required and traffic will be detoured around the work area. These closings are unavoidable for the type of work involved. While there will be some short-term inconveniences the final result will greatly enhance the downtown area and add to traffic calming. This, in particular, has been a major concern to pedestrians, shoppers, schoolchildren alike.

“This half-million dollar project is targeted to be completed before the end of this calendar year, weather of course permitting,” added Mayor Pikolycky.” And I do reassure all those who have been calling Borough Hall that our December 14 holiday parade is still on schedule, the route to be determined shortly.”
