**TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION:
ONCE A WEEK EVERY THURSDAY**

NO TRASH OR RECYCLING ON: THANKSGIVING DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY AND NEW YEARS
DAY * COLLECTION WILL BE THE NEXT DAY

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION:

- 1) All trash and recycling must be placed at curbside.
- 2) All trash must be in metal or plastic containers w/ lids & exterior handles.
- 3) Recycling containers must be labeled.
- 4) No trash will be collected in cardboard boxes.
- 5) No plastic grocery bags are to be placed in the recycling containers.
- 5) No trash or recycling containers over 50 lbs will be collected.
- 6) No 55 gallon drums will be collected.
- 7) Trash and recycling must be placed curbside by 6 A.M.
- 8) Residents are to put out their trash and recycling no earlier than the night before collection.
- 9) All businesses will have to seek their own trash removal (with exception to those excluded by Borough Ordinance.)

BRUSH COLLECTION: ONCE A WEEK ON TUESDAYS

- 1) Long branches must be placed at the curb in neat piles.
- 2) **Branches must be placed at the curb the night before or by 6:00 AM the day of pick-up**
- 3) Branches (from trimming or pruning) more than 8 inches in diameter and 8 ft in length will not be picked-up
- 4) Any brush, stumps or branches from a lot clearing or tree removal is the **RESIDENT'S** responsibility to dispose of.
- 5) Builders & Landscapers are responsible for their own removal of brush **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

LEAF COLLECTION: ONCE A WEEK ON WEDNESDAYS

- 1) Fall collection will be from ** **NOVEMBER 1st TO DECEMBER 20th** **
- 2) Spring collection will be from ** **MARCH 15th TO MAY 15th** **
- 3) Leaves must be raked to curbside in neat piles. **PAPER BAGS ONLY!**
- 3) Leaves must be clean (FREE OF TRASH, TWIGS, DIRT & STONE)

BULKY WASTE COLLECTION: ONCE A WEEK ON THURSDAYS

Bulky waste is defined as "HOUSEHOLD BULKY WASTE" such as furniture, rugs, carpets and other large household items

- 1) **One** item can be placed at the curbside by 6:00AM the morning of pick-up with regular trash.
- 2) **No lumber, building material or landscaping materials will be picked -up.**
- 3) **Businesses are responsible for their own trash disposal, with the exception of recyclable items.**

WHITE GOODS COLLECTION: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY 861-2371

White Goods are defined as "WHITE METALS", such as refrigerators, washers dryers. "SCRAP METALS" will also be collected with white goods.

- 1) Doors must be removed from all freezers and refrigerators before they placed at the curb for pick-up
- 2) Items may be placed at the curb the night before and no later then 6:00AM the day of pick-up
- 3) NO PHONE CALL, NO PICK-UP.

MOTOR OIL:

- 1) Motor oil must be placed in clear containers and can be brought to the Public Work Garage located at Madison and Longfellow Avenues on Monday thru Fridays from 7:00AM to 1:00PM
- 2) Motor oil will **NOT** collected at the curb.

TIRES:

- 1) Tires will not be picked up by the Borough of Woodbine
- 2) Tires must be source separated and recycled by the generator at authorized Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority recycling facilities or any NJDEP approved recycling center;

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS MUST BE SOURCE SEPARATED AND RECYCLED BY THE GENERATOR AT AUTHORIZED CMCMUA RECYCLING FACILITIES OR ANY NJDEP APPROVED RECYCLING CENTER:

- 1) Wood Pallets and Crates
- 2) Propane Tanks
- 3) Electronics
- 4) Antifreeze
- 5) Batteries
- 6) Kerosene/ #2 Heating Oil
- 7) Asphalt & Concrete
- 8) Auto & Truck Bodies
- 9) Contaminated Soil
- 10) Cooking Grease
- 11) Consumer Rechargeable NiCad & Small Sealed Lead Acid Batteries

HAZARDOUS WASTE INFORMATION:

The only way to properly dispose of unwanted paints, thinners, varnishes and other hazardous household materials is as follows:

- 1) The only paint that can be disposed of in your regular trash is waterbased latex paint. Remove the lid and let the paint set until it is dried out. Then it can be disposed of.
- 2) Oil -based paints, thinners, shellacs varnishes, paint removers, stains and other hazardous household materials can only be properly disposed of by taking them to the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority's Hazardous Materials Collection Location. For further information, contact the **CMCMUA AT 465-9026** There are two collections per year, one in the early Fall and one in early Spring.

REMEMBER THAT WE WILL NOT COLLECT ANY HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AT THE CURBSIDE. YOU MUST STORE THESE MATERIALS AND DISPOSE OF THE PROPERLY AT THE CMCMUA HAZARDOUS COLLECTION LOCATION.
