Borough of Woodbine Response to Incidents of Non-compliance 2023 Annual Stormwater Report

As the Department is aware, the Borough was notified of a redesignation from a Tier B to a Tier A community under the MS4 General Stormwater Permit Program in July 2022. The Borough filed an Appeal and Stay request from this determination and thereafter agreed to seek alternate dispute resolution through the Office of Administrative Hearing and Dispute Resolution. An initial meeting was held on April 26, 2023 and after some exchange of information, Richard Tonetta, Esq., the Borough Solicitor, submitted a position letter with attachments (being 46 pages in total) on October 11, 2023. On April 3,, 2024, Mr. Tonetta received an email response to the October 11th letter basically stating that the Tier reassignment decision has not changed. Since no specific responses to the points contained in the Solicitor's letter were provided, a more detailed response from the Department was requested by him. We have been advised that a detailed response from the Department is forthcoming, but we have yet to receive it. Furthermore, Mr. Tonetta, in an email dated April 9 2024, reached out to Daniel Kuti of the Department, advising that until such time as we receive and can review the Department's detailed response, the Borough cannot make an informed decision regarding the appeal process, and he requested a further stay on compliance deadlines pending completion of the appeal process.

While the Borough continues to disagree with the reassignment decision, we have listened to the arguments and been cooperating with the Department to the extent feasible throughout the appeal process. In that regard and without prejudicing any of the Borough's rights to continue to pursue the appeal, the 2023 Tier A Annual Report is being filed and responses provided to the best of our ability at this time. As noted in the report, there are 14 different identified permit compliance issues which are summarized as follows:

- 1. Your municipality has not revised your Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan to incorporate changes required by the renewal permit.
- 2. Your municipality did not adopt a Pet Waste Ordinance.
- 3. Your municipality did not adopt an Improper Disposal of Waste Ordinance.
- 4. Your municipality did not adopt a Wildlife Feeding Ordinance.
- 5. Your municipality did not adopt a Containerized Yard Waste Ordinance / Yard Waste Collection Program Ordinance.
- 6. Your municipality did not adopt an Illicit Connection Ordinance.
- 7. Your municipality did not adopt a Private Storm Drain Inlet Retrofitting Ordinance.
- 8. Your municipality is not distributing the Pet Waste Information Sheets with pet licenses.
- 9. Your municipality has not completed the MS4 outfall pipes mapping.
- 10. Your municipality has not completed an illicit connection inspection for all outfalls.
- 11. Your municipality has not swept all required streets.

Borough of Woodbine Response to Incidents of Non-compliance 2023 Annual Stormwater Report

At the present time, the Borough is evaluating the impact of complying with the above noted items including the timing and affordability of implementing the steps needed to comply.

In addition to the above, there are several questions in the annual report where a specific integer number was required to be entered but the Borough is unable to accurately determine that number at this time. Specifically, these are noted as follows:

Part D

MS4 Outfall Pipe Mapping

Question 3 is noted as 0 but the actual number is undetermined at this time because the mapping has not been completed.

Street Sweeping Program

Question 2 was answered as 1 mile swept but is actually 0 miles. The system would not allow an entry of 0.

Storm Drain Inlet Retrofitting

Question 2 was answered as 0% of inlets meeting the standard. The exact percentage of inlets that are in compliance is unknown at this time, but the system would not allow the use of the term "unknown".
